

Figure 4. Epigenetic inheritance and experimental rescue of macronuclear A gene deletions. (A) Wild-type strain. (B) The d48 strain lacks the A gene in its macronucleus, but has a wild-type micronucleus. The A gene is reproducibly deleted during macronuclear development in each generation. (C) Transformation of the d48 strain macronucleus with A gene sequences restores amplification of the germline A gene in the developing macronucleus of sexual progeny.
